BY-LAW AMENDMENT

New Section

Sec. 13.3 A club within our Aerie may be established, maintained and operated as long as it is approved, by the local Aerie, and is in full compliance with the laws, rules and regulations adopted by the Grand, State and Local Aeries.

The Club shall establish its own by-laws, as long as they do not conflict with the Grand, State and Local Aeries. No club or member shall use the name "Eagle" or any emblem or insignia of the order, intended to convey the impression that they are connected with the Fraternal Order of Eagles, unless they are in compliance with the FOE laws, rules and regulations.

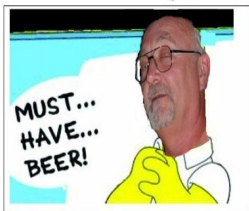

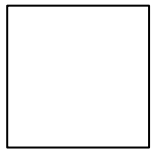
